A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to authorize additional compensation to be paid to certain veterans in receipt of compensation for a service-connected disability rated totally disabling for whom a family member dependent on the veteran for support provides care.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Disabled Veterans’
5 Caregiver Compensation Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION FOR DISABLED VET-**
2 **ERANS IN NEED OF REGULAR AID AND AT-**
3 **TENDANCE WHO HAVE DEPENDENT FAMILY**
4 **MEMBER CAREGIVERS.**

5 Section 1115 of title 38, United States Code, is
6 amended by adding at the end the following new para-
7 graph:

8 “(3) If and while rated totally disabled and in
9 need of regular aid and attendance and while unpaid
10 aid and attendance is provided by an adult family
11 member who is dependent upon such veteran for
12 support, \$234.”.
