## A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to provide that military retired pay for nonregular service shall be paid without regard to the age of a person otherwise eligible for such retired pay, rather than commencing when an otherwise eligible person attains age 60.

2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. IMMEDIATE RECEIPT OF MILITARY RETIRED**

4                               **PAY FOR NONREGULAR SERVICE.**

5       (a) REPEAL OF RECEIPT AT AGE 60.—Section  
6       12731(a)(1) of title 10, United States Code, is amended—

7                       (1) by striking paragraph (1); and

1           (2) by redesignating paragraphs (2) through  
2           (4) as paragraphs (1) thru (3), respectively.

3           (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by  
4 subsection (a) shall take effect on the first day of the first  
5 month beginning after the date of the enactment of this  
6 Act and shall apply with respect to retired pay payable  
7 for that month and subsequent months.
