A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to convey certain facilities to the Fremont-Madison Irrigation District.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Fremont-Madison Con-
- 5 veyance Act".

1 SEC. 2. CONVEYANCE OF FACILITIES.

- 2 (a) Conveyance Requirement.—The Secretary of
- 3 the Interior shall convey to the Fremont-Madison Irrigation
- 4 District, Idaho, as soon as practicable after the date of en-
- 5 actment of this Act and in accordance with all applicable
- 6 law and pursuant to the terms of the memorandum of agree-
- 7 ment between the District and the Secretary (Contract No.
- 8 1425-01-MA-10-3310). The Secretary shall include in the
- 9 facilities conveyed under this section all right, title, and
- 10 interest of the United States in and to the canals, laterals,
- 11 drains, and other components of the water distribution and
- 12 drainage system that is operated or maintained by the Dis-
- 13 trict for delivery of water to and drainage of water from
- 14 lands within the boundaries of the District as they exist
- 15 upon the date of enactment of this Act, consistent with sec-
- 16 tion 7.
- 17 (b) Report.—If the Secretary has not completed any
- 18 conveyance required under this Act by September 13, 2003,
- 19 the Secretary shall, by no later than that date, submit a
- 20 report to the Congress explaining the reasons that convey-
- 21 ance has not been completed and stating the date by which
- 22 the conveyance will be completed.
- 23 **SEC. 3. COSTS.**
- 24 (a) In General.—The Secretary shall require, as a
- 25 condition of the conveyance under section 2, that the Dis-
- 26 trict pay the administrative costs of the conveyance and re-

- 1 lated activities, including the costs of any review required
- 2 under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (42)
- 3 U.S.C. 4321 et seq.) as described in Contract No. 1425-
- 4 01-MA-10-3310.
- 5 (b) Value of Facilities To Be Transferred.—In
- 6 addition to subsection (a) the Secretary shall also require,
- 7 as condition of the conveyance under section 2, that the Dis-
- 8 trict pay to the United States the lesser of the net present
- 9 value of the remaining obligations owed by the District to
- 10 the United States with respect to the facilities conveyed, or
- 11 \$280,000. Amounts received by the United States under this
- 12 subsection shall be deposited into the reclamation fund.
- 13 SEC. 4. TETON EXCHANGE WELLS.
- 14 (a) Contracts and Permit.—In conveying the Teton
- 15 Exchange Wells under section 2, the Secretary shall also
- 16 convey to the District—
- 17 (1) Idaho Department of Water Resources permit
- 18 number 22–7022, including drilled wells under the
- 19 permit, as described in Contract No. 1425–01–MA-
- 20 10–3310; and
- 21 (2) all equipment appurtenant to such wells.
- 22 (b) Extension of Water Service Contract.—The
- 23 water service contract between the Secretary and the Dis-
- 24 trict (Contract No. 7-07-10-W0179, dated September 16,
- 25 1977) is hereby extended and shall continue in full force

- 1 and effect until all conditions described in this Act are ful-
- 2 filled.
- 3 SEC. 5. NATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY ACT OF 1969.
- 4 Prior to conveyance the Secretary shall complete all
- 5 actions as may be required under the National Environ-
- 6 mental Policy Act of 1969 (42 U.S.C. 4321 et seq.).
- 7 SEC. 6. LIABILITY.
- 8 Effective on the date of the conveyance of the facilities
- 9 described in section 2, the United States shall not be held
- 10 liable by any court for damages of any kind arising out
- 11 of any act, omission, or occurrence relating to the conveyed
- 12 facilities, except for damages caused by acts of negligence
- 13 committed by the United States or by its employees, agents,
- 14 or contractors prior to the date of conveyance. Nothing in
- 15 this section may be deemed to increase the liability of the
- 16 United States beyond that currently provided in chapter
- 17 171 of title 28, United States Code, popularly known as
- 18 the Federal Tort Claims Act.
- 19 SEC. 7. WATER SUPPLY TO DISTRICT LANDS.
- 20 The Secretary shall increase the number of acres with-
- 21 in the District that are eligible to receive water from the
- 22 Minidoka Project and the Teton Basin Projects to reflect
- 23 the number of acres within the District as of the date of
- 24 enactment of this Act, which includes lands annexed into
- 25 the District prior to enactment of this Act as intended by

- 1 the Teton Basin Project. This section does not in any way
- 2 authorize the use of any additional Federal Reclamation
- 3 project water beyond that which is currently authorized
- 4 under their existing water storage contracts and as allowed
- 5 by State water law.

6 SEC. 8. EXISTING RIGHTS NOT AFFECTED.

- 7 Nothing in this Act affects the rights of any person
- 8 except as provided in this Act. Any conveyance under this
- 9 Act shall not affect or abrogate any provision of any con-
- 10 tract executed by the United States or State law regarding
- 11 any irrigation district's right to use water developed in the
- 12 facilities conveyed.
- 13 SEC. 9. DEFINITIONS.
- 14 In this Act:
- 15 (1) District.—The term "District" means the
- 16 Fremont-Madison Irrigation District, an irrigation
- 17 district organized under the law of the State of Idaho.
- 18 (2) Secretary.—The term "Secretary" means
- 19 the Secretary of the Interior.
