Mr. DOOLEY of California (for himself and Mr. RADANOVICH) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Small Business

A BILL

To allow certain interagency task forces established by the President to designate certain areas as HUBZones for purposes of the Small Business Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF HUBZONES BY CERTAIN FED-**
4 **ERAL TASK FORCES.**

5 Section 3(p)(1) of the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C.
6 632(p)(1)) is amended—

7 (1) in subparagraph (C) by striking “or”;

8 (2) in subparagraph (D) by striking the period

9 at the end and inserting “; or”; and

1 (3) by adding at the end the following new sub-
2 paragraph:

3 “(E) areas that are within the geographic
4 jurisdiction of, and are designated as
5 HUBZones by—

6 “(i) the Interagency Task Force on
7 the Economic Development of the Central
8 San Joaquin Valley (established by Execu-
9 tive Order 13173 (65 Fed. Reg. 64579));

10 “(ii) the Interagency Task Force on
11 the Economic Development of the South-
12 west Border (established by Executive
13 Order 13122 (42 U.S.C. 3121 note)); or

14 “(iii) any interagency task force es-
15 tablished by an Executive order of the
16 President and identified therein as having
17 authority to designate HUBZones for the
18 purposes of this Act.”.
