1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Holocaust Restitution3 Tax Fairness Act of 2002".

4 SEC. 2. REPEAL OF APPLICABILITY OF SUNSET OF THE
5 ECONOMIC GROWTH AND TAX RELIEF REC6 ONCILIATION ACT OF 2001 WITH RESPECT TO
7 EXCLUSION FROM FEDERAL INCOME TAX
8 FOR RESTITUTION RECEIVED BY VICTIMS OF
9 NAZI REGIME.

Section 901 of the Economic Growth and Tax Relief
Reconciliation Act of 2001 is amended by adding at the
end the following new subsection:

"(c) EXCEPTION.—Subsection (a) shall not apply to
section 803 (relating to no federal income tax on restitution received by victims of the Nazi regime or their heirs
or estates).".
