- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Holocaust Restitution
- 5 Tax Fairness Act of 2002".

7	Section 901 of the Economic Growth and Tax Relief
8	Reconciliation Act of 2001 is amended by adding at the
9	end the following new subsection:
10	"(c) Exception.—Subsection (a) shall not apply to
11	section 803 (relating to no federal income tax on restitu-
12	tion received by victims of the Nazi regime or their heirs
13	or estates).".
