A BILL

To amend the Federal Power Act to prohibit round trip sales of electric power, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Truth in Electricity
- 5 Trading Act of 2002".
- 6 SEC. 2. PROHIBITION OF ROUND TRIP SALES OF ELECTRIC
- 7 **POWER.**
- 8 (a) Prohibition.—Part II of the Federal Power Act
- 9 is amended by adding the following new section at the end
- 10 thereof:

1 "SEC. 215. PROHIBITION OF ROUND TRIP SALES OF ELEC-

- 2 TRIC POWER.
- 3 "It shall be unlawful for any person or other entity
- 4 to enter into any contract or other arrangement to pur-
- 5 chase from any person or other entity and subsequently
- 6 sell to such person or entity, or to sell to any person or
- 7 other entity and subsequently purchase from such person
- 8 or entity, within any 7-day period the same quantity of
- 9 electric power at wholesale at the same price.".
- 10 (b) Jurisdiction.—(1) Sections 201(b)(2) and
- 11 201(e) of such Act are each amended by striking "and
- 12 212" and inserting "212, and 215".
- 13 (2) Section 201(f) of such Act is amended by insert-
- 14 ing "(other than section 215)".
- 15 (c) Penalties.—(1) Section 316(c) of such Act is
- 16 amended by striking "or 214" and inserting "214, or
- 17 215".
- 18 (2) Section 316A of such Act is amended by striking
- 19 "or 214" in each place it appears and inserting "214, or
- 20 215".
