### 107TH CONGRESS 2D SESSION H.R. 4874

To direct the Secretary of the Interior to disclaim any Federal interest in lands adjacent to Spirit Lake and Twin Lakes in the State of Idaho resulting from possible omission of lands from an 1880 survey.

# A BILL

- To direct the Secretary of the Interior to disclaim any Federal interest in lands adjacent to Spirit Lake and Twin Lakes in the State of Idaho resulting from possible omission of lands from an 1880 survey.
  - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
  - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

#### **3** SECTION 1. FINDINGS AND PURPOSE.

- 4 (a) FINDINGS.—The Congress finds the following:
- 5 (1) The meander lines in the original surveys by6 John B. David, deputy surveyor, of two lakes in the
- 7 State of Idaho, Spirit Lake, formerly known as Lake
- 8 Tesemini, located in T. 53 N., R. 4 W., Boise Merid-

ian, and Twin Lakes, formerly known as Fish Lake,
 located in T. 52 N. and T. 53 N., R. 4 W., Boise
 Meridian, do not reflect the current line of ordinary
 high water conditions.

5 (2) All lands adjacent to the original meander6 lines have been patented.

7 (b) PURPOSE.—The purpose of this Act is to direct 8 the Secretary of the Interior to issue a recordable dis-9 claimer of interest by the United States to any omitted 10 lands or lands lying outside the record meander lines in 11 the vicinity of the lakes referred to in subsection (a).

#### 12 SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.

13 In this Act:

14 (1) Recordable disclaimer of interest.— 15 The term "recordable disclaimer of interest" means 16 a document recorded in the county clerk's office or 17 other such local office where real property docu-18 ments are recorded, in which the United States dis-19 claims any right, title, or interest to those lands 20 found lying outside the recorded meander lines of 21 the lakes referred to in section 1(a)(1), including 22 omitted lands, if any.

(2) OMITTED LANDS.—The term "omitted
lands" means those lands that were in place on the
date of the original surveys referred to in section

1 1(a)(1) but were not included in the survey of the
 2 township and the meander lines of the water body
 3 due to gross error or fraud by the original surveyor.
 4 (3) SECRETARY.—The term "Secretary" means
 5 the Secretary of the Interior.

#### 6 SEC. 3. SURVEYS.

7 The Secretary shall—

8 (1) conduct a survey investigation of the condi-9 tions along the lakeshores of Spirit Lake and Twin 10 Lakes in the townships referenced in section 1(a); 11 and

(2) after the completion of the survey investigation, resurvey the original meander lines along the
lakeshores, using the results of the survey investigation.

#### 16 SEC. 4. DISCLAIMER OF INTEREST IN LANDS ADJACENT TO

## SPIRIT LAKE AND TWIN LAKES, IDAHO.

18 Upon acceptance and approval of the surveys under19 section 3 by the Secretary, the Secretary shall—

(1) prepare a recordable disclaimer of interest
with land descriptions, using the lot or tract numbers of the omitted lands, if any, and lands lying
outside the record meander lines, as shown on the
survey plats; and

(2) record such recordable disclaimer of interest
 simultaneously with the filing of the surveys.

#### 3 SEC. 5. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.

4 There is authorized to be appropriated to the Sec5 retary \$400,000 to carry out this Act. Funds appropriated
6 to carry out the purposes of this Act may be available
7 without fiscal year limitation.
