### SECTION 1. COUNTY RIGHT-OF-WAY TO WEST BUTTE ROAD 2 IN THE STATE OF OREGON. 3 (a) Definitions.—In this Act: 4 (1) West butte road.—The term "West 5 Butte Road" means the unpaved Bureau of Land 6 Management road in the State of Oregon identified 7 on the map as BLM Road 6520. (2) County.—The term "County" means each 8 of Crook County and Deschutes County in the State 9 10 of Oregon. (3) MAP.—The term "map" means the map en-11 12 titled "West Butte Road Right of Way" dated July 13 17, 2002.
