A BILL

To direct the Secretary of the Interior to grant to Deschutes and Crook Counties in the State of Oregon a rightof-way to West Butte Road.

1	SECTION 1. COUNTY RIGHT-OF-WAY TO WEST BUTTE ROAD			
2	IN THE STATE OF OREGON.			
3	(a) Definitions.—In this Act:			
4	(1) West butte road.—The term "West Butte			
5	Road" means the unpaved Bureau of Land Manage-			
6	ment road in the State of Oregon identified on the			
7	map as BLM Road 6520.			
8	(2) County.—The term "County" means each of			
9	Crook County and Deschutes County in the State of			
10	Oregon.			
11	(3) MAP.—The term "map" means the map enti-			
12	tled "West Butte Road Right of Way" dated July 17,			
13	2002.			
14	(4) Secretary.—The term "Secretary" means			
15	the Secretary of the Interior, acting through the Di-			
16	rector of the Bureau of Land Management.			
17	(b) Grant to Counties.—Notwithstanding any other			
18	Act, and subject to subsection (d), the Secretary shall grant			
19	to each County a right-of-way to the West Butte Road.			
20	(c) Boundaries.—			
21	(1) In general.—Subject to paragraph (2), the			
22	rights-of-way granted under subsection (b) shall—			
23	(A) extend in length from Reservoir Road			
24	in Crook County to United States Route 20 in			
25	Deschutes County, Oregon; and			

1	(B) shall extend in width 100 feet on each
2	side of the centerline of West Butte Road.
3	(2) Modifications.—
4	(A) State roads.—
5	(i) In general.—The Secretary shall
6	amend the existing rights-of-way of each of
7	the Counties as contained in their respective
8	road case files to include the rights-of-way
9	granted under subsection (b).
10	(ii) Effect.—The rights-of-way
11	amended under clause (i) shall be subject to
12	the common terms, conditions, and stipula-
13	tions identified in the Counties' rights-of-
14	way grants that apply on the date of enact-
15	ment of this Act.
16	(iii) Consideration of environ-
17	MENTAL CONCERNS.—Environmental con-
18	cerns associated with any development of
19	the West Butte Road shall be addressed by
20	the County in meeting compliance require-
21	ments associated with State and Federal
22	highway projects and the National Environ-
23	mental Policy Act of 1969 as administered
24	by the Federal Highway Administration.

1	(B) West butte road.—Notwithstanding
2	any other Act, the Secretary shall provide for ad-
3	justment to the right-of-way width and align-
4	ment granted under subsection (b) in portions of
5	the West Butte Road necessary for the road to
6	meet applicable State and Federal highway
7	standards.
8	(d) Relinquishment of Right-of-Way.—The right-
9	of-way granted to each County under subsection (b) shall

9 of-way granted to each County under subsection (b) shall 10 be contingent upon the Counties relinquishing any right, 11 title, or interest in and to any RS 2477 right-of-way claim 12 held by the Counties to the portion of the road known as 13 George Millican Road that is located in the area described 14 in subsection (c)(1).
