## A BILL

- To limit the period of validity of driver's licenses and State identification cards issued to nonimmigrant aliens to the period of validity of nonimmigrant visas.
  - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
  - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
  - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
  - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Drivers' License Integ-
  - 5 rity Act''.

SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON PERIOD OF VALIDITY OF DRIVER'S
LICENSES AND STATE IDENTIFICATION
CARDS ISSUED TO NONIMMIGRANT ALIENS
TO THE PERIOD OF VALIDITY OF NON-
IMMIGRANT VISAS.
(a) In General.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
sion of law, a valid nonimmigrant visa is required for a
nonimmigrant alien to obtain a driver's license or State
identification card in the United States and a driver's li-
cense or State identification card issued in the United
States to a nonimmigrant alien shall be valid only during
the period of validity of the alien's nonimmigrant visa.
(b) AUTHORITY OF ATTORNEY GENERAL.—The At-
torney General shall enter into such discussions with ap-
propriate officials of State and local governments regard-
ing the issuance of driver's licenses and State identifica-
tion cards as are necessary and appropriate to ensure
prompt and efficient compliance with the limitation under
subsection (a).
SEC. 3. GRANT PROGRAM.
The Attorney General shall establish a program of
grants to assist States in issuing appropriate licenses and
identification documents consistent with the requirements
