Mr. CANTOR introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To limit the period of validity of driver's licenses and State identification cards issued to nonimmigrant aliens to the period of validity of nonimmigrant visas.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the "Drivers' License Integ-
5 rity Act".

1 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON PERIOD OF VALIDITY OF DRIVER'S**
2 **LICENSES AND STATE IDENTIFICATION**
3 **CARDS ISSUED TO NONIMMIGRANT ALIENS**
4 **TO THE PERIOD OF VALIDITY OF NON-**
5 **IMMIGRANT VISAS.**

6 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Notwithstanding any other provi-
7 sion of law, a valid nonimmigrant visa is required for a
8 nonimmigrant alien to obtain a driver's license or State
9 identification card in the United States and a driver's li-
10 cense or State identification card issued in the United
11 States to a nonimmigrant alien shall be valid only during
12 the period of validity of the alien's nonimmigrant visa.

13 (b) **AUTHORITY OF ATTORNEY GENERAL.**—The At-
14 torney General shall enter into such discussions with ap-
15 propriate officials of State and local governments regard-
16 ing the issuance of driver's licenses and State identifica-
17 tion cards as are necessary and appropriate to ensure
18 prompt and efficient compliance with the limitation under
19 subsection (a).

20 **SEC. 3. GRANT PROGRAM.**

21 The Attorney General shall establish a program of
22 grants to assist States in issuing appropriate licenses and
23 identification documents consistent with the requirements
24 of this Act.
