A BILL

To amend the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act with respect to public health pesticides.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 3 SECTION 1. PUBLIC HEALTH PESTICIDES; AMENDMENT TO 4 **FEDERAL** INSECTICIDE, FUNGICIDE, 5 RODENTICIDE ACT. 6 The Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide 7 Act (7 U.S.C. 136 et seq.) is amended— 8 (1) in section 2, by amending subsection (nn) to 9 read as follows:

1	"(nn) Public Health Pesticide.—The term 'pub-
2	lic health pesticide' means any pesticide product that—
3	"(1) is a minor use pesticide product registered
4	for use and used predominantly in public health pro-
5	grams for vector control or for other recognized
6	health protection uses, including the prevention or
7	mitigation of viruses, bacteria, or other microorga-
8	nisms (other than viruses, bacteria, or other micro-
9	organisms on or in living man or other living ani-
10	mal) that pose a threat to public health; or
11	"(2) is a pesticide product registered for use
12	and used for vector control or for other recognized
13	health protection uses, including the prevention or
14	mitigation of viruses, bacteria, or other microorga-
15	nisms, or their toxins (other than viruses, bacteria,
16	and other microorganisms on or in living man or
17	other living animal) that pose a threat to public
18	health."; and
19	(2) in section 4—
20	(A) in subsection (i)—
21	(i) in paragraph (4)(B), by inserting
22	"described in section 2(nn)(1)" after "pub-
23	lic health pesticide"; and

1	(ii) in paragraph (5)(F), by inserting
2	"described in section $2(nn)(1)$ " after "pub-
3	lie health pesticide";
4	(B) in subsection (k)(3)(A)(iii), by insert-
5	ing "described in section $2(nn)(1)$ " before the
6	period; and
7	(C) in subsection (n)—
8	(i) by redesignating paragraph (7) as
9	paragraph (8); and
10	(ii) by inserting after paragraph (6)
11	the following paragraph:
12	"(7) Applicability.—This subsection does not
13	apply to any public health pesticide described in sec-
14	tion $2(nn)(2)$ "
