## A BILL

To provide for the retroactive entitlement of Ed W. Freeman to Medal of Honor special pension.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. RETROACTIVE MEDAL OF HONOR SPECIAL
4 PENSION FOR ED W. FREEMAN.

(a) ENTITLEMENT.—(1) Notwithstanding any other
provision of law, Ed W. Freeman of Boise, Idaho, shall
be entitled to the special pension provided for under section 1562 of title 38, United States Code (and antecedent
provisions of law), for months beginning with November
1965 and ending with June 2001.

(2) The entitlement of Ed W. Freeman to special
 pension under paragraph (1) is in addition to the entitle ment of Ed W. Freeman to special pension for months
 after June 2001 under law.

5 (b) AMOUNT.—The amount of special pension pay-6 able under subsection (a) for a month beginning before 7 the date of the enactment of this Act shall be the amount 8 of special pension provided for by law for that month for 9 persons entered and recorded in the Army, Navy, Air 10 Force, and Coast Guard Medal of Honor Roll (or ante-11 cedent Medal of Honor Roll required by law).
