## A BILL

To support the public educational programs of the Army Aviation Heritage Foundation by amending title 10 of the United States Code to elevate the status of the Army Aviation Heritage Foundation to receive surplus military property.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SPECIFIC ELIGIBILITY OF ARMY AVIATION**  
4                       **HERITAGE FOUNDATION TO RECEIVE SUR-**  
5                       **PLUS MILITARY PROPERTY.**

6       (a) TITLE 10 AUTHORITY.—Section 2572 of title 10,  
7       United States Code, is amended—

1           (1) in subsection (a), by adding at the end the  
2 following new paragraph:

3           “(8) The Army Aviation Heritage Foundation,  
4 a nonprofit organization incorporated in the State of  
5 Georgia.”; and

6           (2) in subsection (d)(2)—

7           (A) in subparagraph (B), by striking “a  
8 recognized war veterans’ association” and in-  
9 serting “an entity described in paragraph (5) or  
10 (8) of subsection (a)”;

11           (B) by adding at the end the following new  
12 subparagraph:

13           “(C) In the case of the donation of an aircraft or  
14 other surplus equipment to the entity described in para-  
15 graph (8) of subsection (a) that is in flyable or usable con-  
16 dition at the time the aircraft or equipment is determined  
17 to be available for donation under this section, the Sec-  
18 retary concerned shall maintain the aircraft or equipment  
19 in flyable or usable condition pending the donation to fa-  
20 cilitate the prompt utilization of the aircraft or equipment  
21 by the entity in its aerial and educational living history  
22 demonstrations.”.

23           (b) DESIGNATION AS SERVICE EDUCATIONAL ACTIV-  
24 ITY.—The Army Aviation Heritage Foundation, a non-  
25 profit organization incorporated in the State of Georgia,

1 is hereby designated as a Service Educational Activity for  
2 purposes of the Department of Defense personal property  
3 donation program, and the Secretary of Defense shall  
4 enter into a formal donation agreement with the Army  
5 Aviation Heritage Foundation.
