# A BILL

To amend the Labor-Management Reporting and Disclosure Act of 1959 to inform union members of their rights.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Informed Union Mem-
- 5 ber Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. INFORMATION.
- 7 Section 105 of the Labor-Management Reporting and
- 8 Disclosure Act of 1959 (29 U.S.C. 415) is amended by
- 9 adding at the end the following: "A labor organization
- 10 shall provide such information—

"(1) to each new member within 90 days after the member has joined the labor organization; and "(2) periodically to all members in a manner which the Secretary of Labor determines will promote a fuller understanding of the member's rights and judicial remedies under this Act.".

### 7 SEC. 3. REGULATIONS.

- 8 Not later than 6 months after the date of the enact-
- 9 ment of this Act, the Secretary of Labor shall review and
- 10 revise all regulations promulgated before such date to im-
- 11 plement the amendments made in this Act to the Labor-
- 12 Management Reporting and Disclosure Act of 1959.
- 13 SEC. 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.
- 14 The amendments made by this Act shall take effect
- 15 180 days after the date of the enactment of this Act.
