Mr. MICA (for himself, Mr. KELLER, Mr. WELDON of Florida, Mr. STEARNS, Mr. BISHOP, and Ms. BROWN of Florida) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To amend the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 to ensure public safety officers receive benefits.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LINE OF DUTY.**

4 Section 1204 of title I of the Omnibus Crime Control
5 and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C. 3796b) is
6 amended—

7 (1) in paragraph (6) by striking “and” after
8 the semicolon;

9 (2) in paragraph (7), by striking the period and
10 inserting “; and”; and

1 (3) by adding at the end the following:

2 “(8) ‘line of duty’ means—

3 “(A) any action which a public safety offi-
4 cer is obligated or authorized by rule, regula-
5 tion, condition of employment or service, or law
6 to perform, including those social, ceremonial,
7 or athletic functions to which the officer is as-
8 signed, or for which the officer is compensated,
9 by the public agency he serves; and

10 “(B) any action which an officer or public
11 employee, as described in subparagraph (A),
12 performs that occurs in a jurisdiction other
13 than that of the employing agency but would
14 otherwise be recognized as obligated or author-
15 ized by rule, regulation, condition of employ-
16 ment or service, or law to perform if the activ-
17 ity had taken place within the jurisdiction of
18 the employing agency.”.
