## A BILL

To provide for the liquidation or reliquidation of certain  
entries of polytetrafluoroethylene.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. LIQUIDATION OR RELIQUIDATION OF CERTAIN**  
4               **ENTRIES OF POLYTETRAFLUOROETHYLENE.**

5       (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding section 514 of  
6 the Tariff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C. 1514), or any other  
7 provision of the law, the Customs Service shall—

8               (1) not later than 90 days after receiving a re-  
9       quest described in subsection (b), liquidate or reliq-

1       update as free from duty the entries listed in sub-  
2       section (c); and

3               (2) within 90 days after such liquidation or re-  
4       liquidation, refund any duties paid with respect to  
5       such entries, including interest from the date of  
6       entry.

7       (b) REQUESTS.—Reliquidation may be made under  
8       subsection (a) with respect to an entry described in sub-  
9       section (c) only if a request therefore is filed with the Cus-  
10      toms Service within 90 days after the date of enactment  
11      of the Act.

12      (c) ENTRIES.—The entries referred to in subsection
