## A BILL

To amend title 23, United States Code, to waive certain  
limitations.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. VEHICLE WEIGHT LIMITATIONS—INTERSTATE**  
4               **SYSTEM.**

5       Section 127 of title 23, United States Code, is  
6       amended by adding at the end the following:

7       “(i) WAIVER OF CERTAIN LIMITATIONS FOR CER-  
8       TAIN ROUTES ON MISSISSIPPI HIGHWAYS.—For any vehi-  
9       cle hauling sand, gravel, wood chips, wood shavings, saw-  
10       dust, fill dirt, agricultural products, or unprocessed for-  
11       estry products, or any combination thereof on Interstate

1 Route 59, Interstate Route 55, Interstate Route 20, or  
2 Interstate Route 10 in the State of Mississippi, a tandem  
3 axle weight of 34,000 pounds established in subsection (a)  
4 shall be 40,000 pounds and a gross weight of at least  
5 80,000 pounds for vehicle combinations of 5 axles estab-  
6 lished under subsection (a) shall be 84,000 pounds.”.
