3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Office of Federal
5 Housing Enterprise Oversight Funding Reform Act of
6 2002”.

1 **SEC. 2. AVAILABILITY OF AMOUNTS IN FEDERAL HOUSING**
2 **ENTERPRISES OVERSIGHT FUND.**

3 Section 1316 of the Federal Housing Enterprises Fi-
4 nancial Safety and Soundness Act of 1992 (12 U.S.C.
5 4516) is amended—

6 (1) in subsection (a), by striking “to the extent
7 provided in appropriation Acts,”; and

8 (2) in subsection (f), in the third sentence, by
9 striking “, to the extent provided in appropriation
10 Acts and subsection (e),”.
