## A BILL

To amend title 5, United States Code, to provide that the Civil Service Retirement and Disability Fund be excluded from the budget of the United States Government.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2        *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3        **SECTION 1. EXCLUSION OF CIVIL SERVICE RETIREMENT**  
4        **AND DISABILITY FUND FROM BUDGET.**

5        Section 8348 of title 5, United States Code, is  
6        amended by adding at the end the following:

1       “(n) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the  
2 receipts and disbursements of the Fund—

3           “(1) shall not be included in the totals of—

4               “(A) the budget of the United States Gov-  
5 ernment as submitted by the President; or

6               “(B) the congressional budget (including  
7 allocations of budget authority and outlays pro-  
8 vided therein);

9           “(2) shall be exempt from any general budget  
10 limitation imposed by statute on expenditures and  
11 net lending (budget outlays) of the United States  
12 Government; and

13           “(3) shall be exempt from any order issued  
14 under part C of the Balanced Budget and Emer-  
15 gency Deficit Control Act of 1985.”.
