3 **SECTION 1. SPECIAL DIABETES PROGRAMS FOR TYPE I DI-**
4 **ABETES AND INDIANS.**

5 (a) SPECIAL DIABETES PROGRAMS FOR TYPE I DIA-
6 BETES.—Section 330B(b)(2) of the Public Health Service
7 Act (42 U.S.C. 254c–2(b)(2)) is amended—

1 (1) in subparagraph (A), by striking “and” at
2 the end;

3 (2) in subparagraph (B), by striking the period
4 at the end and inserting “; and”; and

5 (3) by adding at the end the following new sub-
6 paragraph:

7 “(C) \$150,000,000 for each of fiscal years
8 2004 through 2008.”.

9 (b) SPECIAL DIABETES PROGRAMS FOR INDIANS.—
10 Section 330C(c)(2) of the Public Health Service Act (42
11 U.S.C. 254c-3(c)(2)) is amended—

12 (1) in subparagraph (A), by striking “and” at
13 the end;

14 (2) in subparagraph (B), by striking the period
15 at the end and inserting “; and”; and

16 (3) by adding at the end the following new sub-
17 paragraph:

18 “(C) \$150,000,000 for each of fiscal years
19 2004 through 2008.”.

20 (c) EXTENSION OF FINAL REPORT ON GRANT PRO-
21 GRAMS.—Section 4923(b)(2) of the Balanced Budget Act
22 of 1997 (Public Law 105-33; 111 Stat. 251), as amended
23 by section 931(c) of BIPA (114 Stat. 2763A-585), is
24 amended by striking “2003” and inserting “2007”.
