## A BILL

To provide the same immigration adjustment rights for Haitians as is provided for Cubans.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Haitian Immigrant  
5 Equitable Adjustment Act of 2002”.

1 **SEC. 2. APPLICATION OF CUBAN ADJUSTMENT ACT TO HAI-**  
2 **TIANS.**

3 Effective as of the date of the enactment of this Act,  
4 the first section of Public Law 89–732 (8 U.S.C. 1255  
5 note) is amended by inserting “or Haiti” after “Cuba”.
