## A BILL

To extend the national flood insurance program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF NATIONAL FLOOD INSURANCE**  
4 **PROGRAM.**

5 (a) BORROWING AUTHORITY.—Section 1309(a)(2) of  
6 the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C.  
7 4016(a)(2)) is amended by striking “December 31, 2002”  
8 and inserting “December 31, 2004”.

9 (b) AUTHORITY TO WRITE POLICIES.—Section 1319  
10 of the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C.  
11 4026) is amended by striking “after” and all that follows

1 through the period at the end and inserting “after Decem-  
2 ber 31, 2004.”.

3 (c) EMERGENCY IMPLEMENTATION OF PROGRAM.—  
4 Section 1336(a) of the National Flood Insurance Act of  
5 1968 (42 U.S.C. 4056(a)) is amended by striking “end-  
6 ing” and all that follows through “in” and inserting “end-  
7 ing December 31, 2004, in”.

8 (d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS FOR STUD-  
9 IES.—Section 1376(c) of the National Flood Insurance  
10 Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C. 4127) is amended by striking “De-  
11 cember 31, 2002” and inserting “December 31, 2004”.
