A BILL

To provide for the resolution of certain labor issues relating to the merger of the Metro-North Railroad and the Long Island Rail Road.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. EXTINGUISHMENT.
- 4 Upon the merger of the Metro-North Railroad and
- 5 the Long Island Rail Road, the collective bargaining
- 6 agreement between the Association of Commuter Rail Em-
- 7 ployees and the Metro-North Railroad shall be extin-
- 8 guished.

1 SEC. 2. DEEMED COVERAGE.

- 2 Employees of the entity resulting from the merger de-
- 3 scribed in section 1 shall be deemed to be covered under
- 4 the appropriate collective bargaining agreement of the
- 5 Long Island Rail Road in compliance with the Railway
- 6 Labor Act.

7 SEC. 3. SENIORITY.

- 8 At the time of the merger described in section 1, the
- 9 appropriate seniority roster of Metro-North Railroad em-
- 10 ployees shall be added to the bottom of the seniority roster
- 11 of Long Island Rail Road employees.
- 12 SEC. 4. DISPUTES.
- All disputes arising from the application of this Act
- 14 shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the National Medi-
- 15 ation Board.
