AN ACT

To redesignate certain lands within the Craters of the Moon
National Monument, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SPECIAL MANAGEMENT REQUIREMENTS FOR**
4 **FEDERAL LANDS RECENTLY ADDED TO CRA-**
5 **TERS OF THE MOON NATIONAL MONUMENT,**
6 **IDAHO.**

7 (a) REDESIGNATION.—The approximately 410,000
8 acres of land added to the Craters of the Moon National

1 Monument by Presidential Proclamation 7373 of Novem-
2 ber 9, 2000, and identified on the map accompanying the
3 Proclamation for administration by the National Park
4 Service, shall, on and after the date of enactment of this
5 Act, be known as the “Craters of the Moon National Pre-
6 serve”.

7 (b) ADMINISTRATION.—

8 (1) IN GENERAL.—Except as provided by para-
9 graph (2), the Craters of the Moon National Pre-
10 serve shall be administered in accordance with—

11 (A) Presidential Proclamation 7373 of No-
12 vember 9, 2000;

13 (B) the Act of June 8, 1906, (commonly
14 referred to as the “Antiquities Act”; 34 Stat.
15 225; 16 U.S.C. 431); and

16 (C) the laws generally applicable to units
17 of the National Park System, including the Act
18 entitled “An Act to establish a National Park
19 Service, and for other purposes”, approved Au-
20 gust 25, 1916 (16 U.S.C. 1 et seq.).

21 (2) HUNTING.—The Secretary of the Interior
22 shall permit hunting on lands within the Craters of
23 the Moon National Preserve in accordance with the
24 applicable laws of the United States and the State
25 of Idaho. The Secretary, in consultation with the

1 State of Idaho, may designate zones where, and es-
2 tablish periods when, no hunting may be permitted
3 for reasons of public safety, protection of the area's
4 resources, administration, or public use and enjoy-
5 ment. Except in emergencies, any regulations pre-
6 scribing such restrictions relating to hunting shall be
7 put into effect only after consultation with the State
8 of Idaho.
