## A BILL

To amend the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938 to provide for an increase in the Federal minimum wage.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-1 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.** This Act may be cited as the "Fair Minimum Wage 4 Act of 2001". SEC. 2. MINIMUM WAGE INCREASE. 6 7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 6(a)(1) of the Fair Labor 8 Standards Act of 1938 (29 U.S.C. 206(a)(1)) is amended to read as follows: 10 "(1) except as otherwise provided in this sec-11 tion, not less than— "(A) \$5.75 an hour beginning 30 days 12 13 after the date of enactment of the Fair Min-14 imum Wage Act of 2001; 15 "(B) \$6.25 an hour during the year begin-16 ning January 1, 2002; and 17 "(C) \$6.65 an hour beginning January 1, 18 2003;". 19 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by 20 this section shall take effect 30 days after the date of en-21 actment of this Act.
