RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 7) to provide incentives for charitable contributions by individuals and businesses, to improve the effectiveness and efficiency of government program delivery to individuals and families in need, and to enhance the ability of low-income Americans to gain financial security by building assets.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order without intervention of any point of
3 order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 7) to provide

1 incentives for charitable contributions by individuals and
2 businesses, to improve the effectiveness and efficiency of
3 government program delivery to individuals and families
4 in need, and to enhance the ability of low-income Ameri-
5 cans to gain financial security by building assets. The bill
6 shall be considered as read for amendment. In lieu of the
7 amendments recommended by the Committees on Ways
8 and Means and the Judiciary now printed in the bill, the
9 amendment in the nature of a substitute printed in the
10 Congressional Record and numbered 1 pursuant to clause
11 8 of rule XVIII shall be considered as adopted. The pre-
12 vious question shall be considered as ordered on the bill,
13 as amended, and on any further amendment thereto to
14 final passage without intervening motion except: (1) one
15 hour of debate on the bill, as amended, equally divided
16 and controlled by the chairman and ranking minority
17 member of the Committee on Ways and Means; (2) the
18 further amendment in the nature of a substitute printed
19 in the report of the Committee on Rules accompanying
20 this resolution, if offered by Representative Rangel of New
21 York, Representative Conyers of Michigan, or a designee,
22 which shall be in order without intervention of any point
23 of order, shall be considered as read, and shall be sepa-
24 rately debatable for one hour equally divided and con-

- 1 trolled by the proponent and an opponent; and (3) one
- 2 motion to recommit with or without instructions.
