RESOLUTION

Providing for further consideration of the bill (H.R. 2586) to authorize appropriations for fiscal year 2002 for military activities of the Department of Defense, to prescribe military personnel strengths for fiscal year 2002, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for further
5 consideration of the bill (H.R. 2586) to authorize appro-

1 priations for fiscal year 2002 for military activities of the
2 Department of Defense, to prescribe military personnel
3 strengths for fiscal year 2002, and for other purposes. No
4 further amendment to the committee amendment in the
5 nature of a substitute shall be in order except those print-
6 ed in the report of the Committee on Rules accompanying
7 this resolution. Each such amendment may be offered only
8 in the order printed in the report, may be offered only
9 by a Member designated in the report, shall be considered
10 as read, shall be debatable for the time specified in the
11 report equally divided and controlled by the proponent and
12 an opponent, shall not be subject to amendment, and shall
13 not be subject to a demand for division of the question
14 in the House or in the Committee of the Whole. All points
15 of order against such amendments are waived. At the con-
16 clusion of consideration of the bill for amendment the
17 Committee shall rise and report the bill to the House with
18 such amendments as may have been adopted. Any Member
19 may demand a separate vote in the House on any amend-
20 ment adopted in the Committee of the Whole to the bill
21 or to the committee amendment in the nature of a sub-
22 stitute. The previous question shall be considered as or-
23 dered on the bill and amendments thereto to final passage
24 without intervening motion except one motion to recommit
25 with or without instructions.
