(1) by striking "Before a Member" and insert-1 2 ing "(a) Before a Member"; and 3 (2) by adding at the end the following: 4 "(b) No Member, Delegate, or Resident Commis-5 sioner may have access to classified information (including access through attendance at any briefing or other event 6 7 at which classified information is presented) unless the Member, Delegate, or Resident Commissioner meets the 8 9 same security clearance and confidentiality requirements as employees of the Permanent Select Committee on Intel-10 11 ligence.".
