- 2 SECTION 1. FURTHER EXPENSES OF THE PERMANENT SE-
- 3 LECT COMMITTEE ON INTELLIGENCE.
- 4 For further expenses of the Permanent Select Com-
- 5 mittee on Intelligence, there shall be paid out of the appli-
- 6 cable accounts of the House of Representatives not more
- 7 than \$1,600,000.
- 8 SEC. 2. LIMITATION.
- 9 Amounts shall be available under this resolution for
- 10 expenses incurred during the period beginning at noon on

- 1 January 3, 2002, and ending immediately before noon on
- 2 January 3, 2003.

### 3 SEC. 3. VOUCHERS.

- 4 Payments under this resolution shall be made on
- 5 vouchers authorized by the Permanent Select Committee
- 6 on Intelligence, signed by the chairman of such committee,
- 7 and approved in the manner directed by the Committee
- 8 on House Administration.

### 9 SEC. 4. REGULATIONS.

- Amounts made available under this resolution shall
- 11 be expended in accordance with regulations prescribed by
- 12 the Committee on House Administration.

#### 13 SEC. 5. ADJUSTMENT AUTHORITY.

- 14 The Committee on House Administration shall have
- 15 authority to make adjustments in amounts under section
- 16 1, if necessary to comply with an order of the President
- 17 issued under section 254 of the Balanced Budget and
- 18 Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985 or to conform to
- 19 any reduction in appropriations for the purposes of such
- 20 section 1.
