Mr. MALONEY of Connecticut submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3884) to amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to prevent corporations from avoiding the United States income tax by reincorporating in a foreign country.

1 *Resolved*, That immediately upon the adoption of this
2 resolution the House shall without intervention of any
3 point of order consider in the House the bill (H.R. 3884)
4 to amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to prevent
5 corporations from avoiding the United States income tax
6 by reincorporating in a foreign country. The bill shall be
7 considered as read for amendment. The previous question
8 shall be considered as ordered on the bill and on any

1 amendment thereto to final passage without intervening
2 motion except:

3 (1) five hours of debate on the bill equally di-
4 vided and controlled by the chairman and ranking
5 minority member of the Committee on Ways and
6 Means;

7 (2) an amendment offered by Representative
8 Neal of Massachusetts or his designee, which shall
9 be in order without intervention of any point of
10 order (except those arising under clause 7 of rule
11 XVI), shall be considered as read, and shall be sepa-
12 rately debatable for 30 minutes equally divided and
13 controlled by the proponent and an opponent;

14 (3) an amendment in the nature of a substitute
15 offered by Representative Thomas of California or
16 his designee, which shall be in order without inter-
17 vention of any point of order (except those arising
18 under clause 7 of rule XVI), shall be considered as
19 read, and shall be separately debatable for two hours
20 equally divided and controlled by the proponent and
21 an opponent; and

22 (4) one motion to recommit with or without in-
23 structions.

24 SEC. 2. During consideration of H.R. 3884 pursuant
25 to the first section of this resolution, notwithstanding the

1 operation of the previous question, the Chair may post-
2 pone further consideration of the bill to a time designated
3 by the Speaker on the same legislative day or until the
4 following legislative day when consideration shall resume
5 immediately after the third daily order of business under
6 clause 1 of rule XIV.
