Mr. HASTINGS of Washington, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 5093) making appropriations for the Department of the Interior and related agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2003, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of  
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 5093) making appropriations for

1 the Department of the Interior and related agencies for  
2 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2003, and for other  
3 purposes. The first reading of the bill shall be dispensed  
4 with. All points of order against consideration of the bill  
5 are waived. General debate shall be confined to the bill  
6 and shall not exceed one hour equally divided and con-  
7 trolled by the chairman and ranking minority member of  
8 the Committee on Appropriations. After general debate  
9 the bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-  
10 minute rule. The amendments printed in the report of the  
11 Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution shall be  
12 considered as adopted in the House and in the Committee  
13 of the Whole. Points of order against provisions in the  
14 bill, as amended, for failure to comply with clause 2 of  
15 rule XXI are waived except as follows: beginning with  
16 “Provided” on page 29, line 22, through page 30, line 11;  
17 page 68, lines 1 through 7. Where points of order are  
18 waived against part of a paragraph, points of order  
19 against a provision in another part of such paragraph may  
20 be made only against such provision and not against the  
21 entire paragraph. During consideration of the bill for fur-  
22 ther amendment, the Chairman of the Committee of the  
23 Whole may accord priority in recognition on the basis of  
24 whether the Member offering an amendment has caused  
25 it to be printed in the portion of the Congressional Record

1 designated for that purpose in clause 8 of rule XVIII.  
2 Amendments so printed shall be considered as read. Dur-  
3 ing consideration of the bill, points of order against  
4 amendments for failure to comply with clause 2(e) of rule  
5 XXI are waived. At the conclusion of consideration of the  
6 bill for amendment the Committee shall rise and report  
7 the bill, as amended, to the House with such further  
8 amendments as may have been adopted. The previous  
9 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and  
10 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening  
11 motion except one motion to recommit with or without in-  
12 structions.
