Mr. CONYERS submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1343) to provide Federal assistance to States and local jurisdictions to prosecute hate crimes, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That immediately upon the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker shall, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the State of the Union for consid-
5 eration of the bill (H.R. 1343) to provide Federal assist-
6 ance to States and local jurisdictions to prosecute hate
7 crimes, and for other purposes. General debate shall be
8 confined to the bill and shall not exceed 60 minutes equal-
9 ly divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking mi-

1 nority member of the Committee on Judiciary. The first
2 reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. After general
3 debate the bill shall be considered for amendment under
4 the 5-minute rule. During consideration of the bill for
5 amendment, the Chairman of the Committee of the Whole
6 may accord priority in recognition on the basis of whether
7 the member offering an amendment has caused it to be
8 printed in the portion of the Congressional Record for that
9 purpose in clause 8 of rule XVIII.

10 SEC. 2. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill
11 for amendment, the Committee shall rise and report the
12 bill to the House with such amendments as may have been
13 adopted. The previous question shall be considered as or-
14 dered on the bill and amendment thereto to final passage
15 without intervening motion, except one motion to recom-
16 mit with or without instructions.

17 SEC. 3. If the Committee of the Whole rises and re-
18 ports that it has come to no resolution on the bill, then
19 on the next legislative day the House shall, immediately
20 after the third daily order of business under clause 1 of
21 rule XIV, resolve into the Committee of the Whole for fur-
22 ther consideration of the bill.
