RESOLUTION

1 *Resolved*, That paragraph (b) of clause 1 of rule XVII
2 of the Rules of the House of Representatives is amended
3 to read as follows:

4 “(b) Remarks in debate, including references to the
5 Senate or its Members, shall be confined to the question
6 under debate, avoiding personality.”.
