Mr. DREIER, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the joint resolution (H.J. Res. 114) to authorize the use of United States Armed Forces against Iraq.

1       *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution  
2 it shall be in order without intervention of any point of  
3 order to consider in the House the joint resolution (H.J.  
4 Res. 114) to authorize the use of United States Armed  
5 Forces against Iraq. The joint resolution shall be consid-  
6 ered as read for amendment. The amendment to the pre-  
7 amble and the amendment to the text recommended by

1 the Committee on International Relations and now printed  
2 in the joint resolution shall be considered as adopted. The  
3 previous question shall be considered as ordered on the  
4 joint resolution, as amended, and on any further amend-  
5 ments thereto to final passage without intervening motion  
6 except: (1) 17 hours of debate on the joint resolution, as  
7 amended, equally divided and controlled by the chairman  
8 and ranking minority member of the Committee on Inter-  
9 national Relations, which may be extended pursuant to  
10 section 2; (2) the further amendments printed in the re-  
11 port of the Committee on Rules accompanying this resolu-  
12 tion, which may be offered only in the order printed in  
13 the report, may be offered only by a Member designated  
14 in the report, shall be in order without intervention of any  
15 point of order or demand for division of the question, shall  
16 be considered as read, and shall be separately debatable  
17 for the time specified in the report equally divided and  
18 controlled by the proponent and an opponent; (3) after  
19 the conclusion of consideration of the amendments printed  
20 in the report of the Committee on Rules, a final period  
21 of debate on the joint resolution, as amended, which shall  
22 not exceed one hour equally divided and controlled by the  
23 chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee  
24 on International Relations; and (4) one motion to recom-  
25 mit with or without instructions.

1        SEC. 2. It shall be in order for the Majority Leader  
2 or his designee, after consultation with the Minority Lead-  
3 er, to move to extend debate on the joint resolution, as  
4 amended. Such motion shall not be subject to debate or  
5 amendment.

6        SEC. 3. During consideration of House Joint Resolu-  
7 tion 114 pursuant to the first section of this resolution,  
8 notwithstanding the operation of the previous question,  
9 the Chair may postpone further consideration of the joint  
10 resolution to a time designated by the Speaker either on  
11 the same legislative day or on the next legislative day.
