  - 1 Resolved,
  - 2 SECTION 1. AMOUNTS FOR COMMITTEE EXPENSES.

For the expenses of the Committee on International Relations (hereafter in this resolution referred to as the ''Committee''), including the expenses of all staff salaries, there shall be paid, out of the applicable accounts of the House of Representatives for committee salaries and expenses, not more than \$14,495,256.00 for the One Hundred Seventh Congress.

  4 available for expenses incurred during the period be5 ginning at noon on January 3, 2001, and ending im6 mediately before noon on January 3, 2002; and
- 7 (2) not more than \$7,491,411.00 shall be avail8 able for expenses incurred during the period begin9 ning at noon on January 3, 2002, and ending imme10 diately before noon on January 3, 2003.

#### 11 SEC. 3. VOUCHERS.

Payments under this resolution shall be made on
vouchers authorized by the Committee, signed by the
Chairman of the Committee, and approved in the manner
directed by the Committee on House Administration.

## 16 SEC. 4. REGULATIONS.
