AN ACT

To extend the deadline for commencement of construction of a hydroelectric project in the State of North Carolina.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF TIME FOR FEDERAL ENERGY

- 2 REGULATORY COMMISSION PROJECT.
- 3 (a) In General.—Notwithstanding the time period
- 4 specified in section 13 of the Federal Power Act (16
- 5 U.S.C. 806) that would otherwise apply to the Federal En-
- 6 ergy Regulatory Commission project number 11437, the
- 7 Commission may, at the request of the licensee for the
- 8 project, and after reasonable notice, in accordance with
- 9 the requirements of that section and the Commission's
- 10 procedures under that section, extend the time period dur-
- 11 ing which the licensee is required to commence the con-
- 12 struction of the project for 3 consecutive 2-year periods.
- 13 (b) Effective Date.—Subsection (a) takes effect
- 14 on the date of the expiration of the extension issued by
- 15 the Commission before the date of the enactment of this
- 16 Act under section 13 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C.
- 17 806).
