# A BILL

To protect infants who are born alive.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Born-Alive Infants5 Protection Act".

#### 6 SEC. 2. DEFINITION OF BORN-ALIVE INFANT.

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 1 of title 1, United
8 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol9 lowing:

"(a) In determining the meaning of any Act of Congress, or of any ruling, regulation, or interpretation of the
various administrative bureaus and agencies of the United
States, the words 'person', 'human being', 'child', and 'individual', shall include every infant member of the species
homo sapiens who is born alive at any stage of development.

10 "(b) As used in this section, the term 'born alive', with respect to a member of the species homo sapiens, 11 12 means the complete expulsion or extraction from his or 13 her mother of that member, at any stage of development, 14 who after such expulsion or extraction breathes or has a 15 beating heart, pulsation of the umbilical cord, or definite 16 movement of voluntary muscles, regardless of whether the umbilical cord has been cut, and regardless of whether the 17 18 expulsion or extraction occurs as a result of natural or 19 induced labor, caesarean section, or induced abortion.

"(c) Nothing in this section shall be construed to affirm, deny, expand, or contract any legal status or legal
right applicable to any member of the species homo sapiens at any point prior to being born alive as defined in
this section.".
