**A BILL**

To authorize the addition of lands to Pu‘uhonua o Hōnaunau  
National Historical Park in the State of Hawaii, and  
for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Pu‘uhonua o  
3 Hōnaunau National Historical Park Addition Act of  
4 2001”.

5 **SEC. 2. ADDITIONS TO PU‘UHONUA O HŌNAUNAU NA-**  
6 **TIONAL HISTORICAL PARK.**

7 The first section of the Act of July 26, 1955 (69 Stat.  
8 376, ch. 385; 16 U.S.C. 397), is amended—

9 (1) by striking “That when” and inserting  
10 “SECTION 1. (a) When”; and

11 (2) by adding at the end thereof the following  
12 new subsections:

13 “(b) The boundaries of Pu‘uhonua o Hōnaunau Na-  
14 tional Historical Park are hereby modified to include ap-  
15 proximately 238 acres of lands and interests therein with-  
16 in the area identified as ‘Parcel A’ on the map entitled  
17 ‘Pu‘uhonua o Hōnaunau National Historical Park Pro-  
18 posed Boundary Additions, Ki‘ilae Village’, numbered  
19 PUHO–P 415/82,013 and dated May, 2001.

20 “(c) The Secretary of the Interior is authorized to  
21 acquire approximately 159 acres of lands and interests  
22 therein within the area identified as ‘Parcel B’ on the map  
23 referenced in subsection (b). Upon the acquisition of such  
24 lands or interests therein, the Secretary shall modify the  
25 boundaries of Pu‘uhonua o Hōnaunau National Historical  
26 Park to include such lands or interests therein.”.

1 **SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATIONS OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

2       There is authorized to be appropriated such sums as  
3 may be necessary to carry out this Act.
