# A BILL

- To direct the Secretary of the Army to repair and expand a wave attenuation system to protect fishermen and other boaters and promote the welfare of the town of Lubec, Maine.
  - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
  - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

### **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Lubec Safe Harbor5 Act of 2001".

### 6 SEC. 2. FINDINGS.

7 Congress finds that—

1	(1) in 1997, a winter storm caused the deaths
2	of 2 fishermen in the town of Lubec, Maine;
3	(2) without a safe berth for their boats, the
4	lives of fishermen and other boaters in Lubec are at
5	risk;
6	(3) storms in the months preceding the date of
7	enactment of this Act have destabilized the wave at-
8	tenuation system in Lubec and consequently caused
9	extensive damage to the Lubec marina;
10	(4) the damage has been devastating to the
11	small town, the economy of which is dependent on
12	fishing and on tourists who arrive by boat;
13	(5) even when in good repair, the wave attenu-
14	ation system in Lubec was not adequate to provide
15	a safe harbor for the town;
16	(6) without a fully effective wave attenuation
17	system, the marina, pier, and harbor will cease to
18	function; and
19	(7) since the town can neither support its fish-
20	ing industry nor provide landing capacity for tour
21	boats without a functional marina, it is imperative
22	that the wave attenuation system be immediately re-
23	paired and expanded to provide safe harbor for the
24	fishing and tourist fleet at the Lubec marina.

## 1 SEC. 3. WAVE ATTENUATION SYSTEM, LUBEC, MAINE.

2 The Secretary of the Army shall repair and expand
3 the wave attenuation system at Lubec, Maine, at a total
4 Federal cost of \$2,200,000.
