## AN ACT

To require the display of the POW/MIA flag at the World War II memorial, the Korean War Veterans Memorial, and the Vietnam Veterans Memorial.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “POW/MIA Memorial  
5       Flag Act of 2002”.

1 **SEC. 2. DISPLAY OF POW/MIA FLAG AT WORLD WAR II ME-**  
 2 **MORIAL, KOREAN WAR MEMORIAL, AND VIET-**  
 3 **NAM VETERANS MEMORIAL.**

4 (a) REQUIREMENT FOR DISPLAY.—Subsection (d)(3)  
 5 of section 902 of title 36, United States Code, is amended  
 6 by striking “The Korean War Veterans Memorial and the  
 7 Vietnam Veterans Memorial” and inserting “The World  
 8 War II memorial, the Korean War Veterans Memorial,  
 9 and the Vietnam Veterans Memorial”.

10 (b) DAYS FOR DISPLAY.—Subsection (c)(2) of that  
 11 section is amended—

12 (1) by redesignating subparagraphs (A) and  
 13 (B) as subparagraphs (B) and (C), respectively; and

14 (2) by inserting before subparagraph (B), as so  
 15 redesignated, the following new subparagraph (A):

16 “(A) in the case of display at the World War  
 17 II memorial, Korean War Veterans Memorial, and  
 18 Vietnam Veterans Memorial (required by subsection  
 19 (d)(3) of this section), any day on which the United  
 20 States flag is displayed;”.

21 (c) DISPLAY ON EXISTING FLAGPOLE.—No element  
 22 of the United States Government may construe the  
 23 amendments made by this section as requiring the acquisi-

- 1 tion of erection of a new or additional flagpole for pur-
- 2 poses of the display of the POW/MIA flag.
