To provide penalties for certain unauthorized writing with respect to consumer products.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Product Packaging

5 Protection Act of 2002".

1 SEC. 2. TAMPERING WITH CONSUMER PRODUCTS.

2 Section 1365 of title 18, United States Code, is
3 amended—

4 (1) by redesignating subsections (f) and (g) as
5 subsections (g) and (h), respectively; and

6 (2) by inserting after subsection (e) the fol-7 lowing:

((f)(1)) Whoever, without the consent of the manufac-8 9 turer, retailer, or distributor, intentionally tampers with 10 a consumer product that is sold in interstate or foreign 11 commerce by knowingly placing or inserting any writing in the consumer product, or in the container for the con-12 13 sumer product, before the sale of the consumer product to any consumer shall be fined under this title, imprisoned 14 15 not more than 1 year, or both.

16 "(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph
17 (1), if any person commits a violation of this subsection
18 after a prior conviction under this section becomes final,
19 such person shall be fined under this title, imprisoned for
20 not more than 3 years, or both.

21 "(3) In this subsection, the term 'writing' means any22 form of representation or communication, including hand-

- 1 bills, notices, or advertising, that contain letters, words,
- 2 or pictorial representations.".
