AN ACT

To designate the United States courthouse to be constructed at 8th Avenue and Mill Street in Eugene, Oregon, as the “Wayne Lyman Morse United States Courthouse”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF WAYNE LYMAN MORSE**
2 **UNITED STATES COURTHOUSE.**

3 The United States courthouse to be constructed at
4 8th Avenue and Mill Street in Eugene, Oregon, shall be
5 known and designated as the “Wayne Lyman Morse
6 United States Courthouse”.

7 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

8 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
9 paper, or other record of the United States to the United
10 States courthouse referred to in section 1 shall be deemed
11 to be a reference to the Wayne Lyman Morse United
12 States Courthouse.
