## **AN ACT**

## 1 SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF UNEMPLOYMENT ASSISTANCE.

- Notwithstanding section 410(a) of the Robert T.
- 3 Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act
- 4 (42 U.S.C. 5177(a)), in the case of any individual eligible
- 5 to receive unemployment assistance under section 410(a)
- 6 of that Act as a result of the terrorist attacks of Sep-
- 7 tember 11, 2001, the President shall make such assistance
- 8 available for 52 weeks after the major disaster is declared.
