## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on acetamiprid.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ACETAMIPRID.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
7 new heading:

“	9902.29.89	N1-[(6-chloro-3-pyridyl) methyl]-N2-cyano-N1-methylacetamide (CAS No. 135410-20-7) (provided for in subheading 2933.39.27) .....	Free	Free	No change	On or before 12/31/2004	”.

1       (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or  
3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after  
4 the 15th day after the date of enactment of this Act.
