A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on railway electric multiple unit (EMU) gallery commuter coaches of stainless steel.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
4 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
5 amended by inserting in the numerical sequence the fol-
6 lowing new subheading:

“	9902.86.09	Railway electric multiple unit (EMU) commuter coaches of stainless steel; the foregoing consisting of two finished EMU gallery-type coaches manufactured to contract specifications each, having an aggregate seating capacity of up to 156 seats (including flip-up seats and wheelchair spaces) on two levels. (provided for in sub-heading 8603.10.00)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/05	”.

1 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the day that is
4 15 days after the date of enactment of this Act.
