

AN ACT

For the relief of Richi James Lesley.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding subsections (a) and (b) of section 201 of the Immigration and Nationality 4 5 Act, Richi James Lesley shall be eligible for issuance of an immigrant visa or for adjustment of status to that of 6 7 an alien lawfully admitted for permanent residence upon 8 filing an application for issuance of an immigrant visa 9 under section 204 of such Act or for adjustment of status 10 to lawful permanent resident.

(b) ADJUSTMENT OF STATUS.—If Richi James Lesley enters the United States before the filing deadline
specified in subsection (c), he shall be considered to have
entered and remained lawfully and shall, if otherwise eligible, be eligible for adjustment of status under section 245
of the Immigration and Nationality Act as of the date of
enactment of this Act.

(c) DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF
FEES.—Subsections (a) and (b) shall apply only if the application for issuance of an immigrant visa or the application for adjustment of status are filed with appropriate
fees within 2 years after the date of enactment of this
Act.

24 (d) REDUCTION OF IMMIGRANT VISA NUMBER.—
25 Upon the granting of an immigrant visa or permanent res26 idence to Richi James Lesley, the Secretary of State shall

instruct the proper officer to reduce by one, during the 1 current or next following fiscal year, the total number of 2 immigrant visas that are made available to natives of the 3 4 country of the alien's birth under section 203(a) of the 5 Immigration and Nationality Act or, if applicable, the total number of immigrant visas that are made available 6 7 to natives of the country of the alien's birth under section 8 202(e) of such Act.

9 (e) EFFECTIVE DATE OF IMMIGRANT STATUS.— 10 Upon the granting of the status of an alien lawfully admit-11 ted for permanent residence to Richi James Lesley under 12 this Act, the Attorney General shall make a record of law-13 ful admission for permanent residence in the case of Richi 14 James Lesley as of the date of the alien's arrival in the 15 United States.
