to the Committee on Health, Education, Labor, and Pensions

A BILL

To prohibit certain abortion-related discrimination in
governmental activities.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ABORTION NON-DISCRIMINATION.**

4 Section 245 of the Public Health Service Act (42
5 U.S.C. 238n) is amended—

6 (1) in the section heading, by striking “RE-
7 GARDING TRAINING AND LICENSING OF PHYSICIANS”
8 and inserting “REGARDING TRAINING, LICENSING,
9 AND PRACTICE OF PHYSICIANS AND OTHER HEALTH
10 CARE ENTITIES”;

1 (2) in subsection (a)(1), by striking “to perform
2 such abortions” and inserting “to perform, provide
3 coverage of, or pay for induced abortions”;

4 (3) in subsection (c)(2)—

5 (A) by inserting “or other health profes-
6 sional,” after “an individual physician”;

7 (B) by striking “and a participant” and in-
8 serting “a participant”; and

9 (C) by inserting before the period the fol-
10 lowing: “, a hospital, a provider sponsored orga-
11 nization, a health maintenance organization, a
12 health insurance plan, or any other kind of
13 health care facility, organization or plan”; and

14 (4) in subsection (b)(1), by striking “stand-
15 ards” and inserting “standard”.
