## **AN ACT**

To reauthorize the United States Institute for Environmental Conflict Resolution, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Environmental Policy
- 5 and Conflict Resolution Advancement Act of 2002".

## 1 SEC. 2. ENVIRONMENTAL DISPUTE RESOLUTION FUND.

2 Section 13 of the Morris K. Udall Scholarship and 3 Excellence in National Environmental and Native American Public Policy Act of 1992 (20 U.S.C. 5609) is amend-4 5 ed by striking subsection (b) and inserting the following: 6 "(b) ENVIRONMENTAL DISPUTE RESOLUTION 7 FUND.—There is authorized to be appropriated to the Environmental Dispute Resolution Fund established by sec-8 tion 10 \$4,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2004 through 9 10 2008, of which—

"(1) \$3,000,000 shall be used to pay operations
costs (including not more than \$1,000 for official reception and representation expenses); and

14 "(2) \$1,000,000 shall be used for grants or 15 other appropriate arrangements to pay the costs of 16 services provided in a neutral manner relating to, 17 and to support the participation of non-Federal enti-18 ties (such as State and local governments, tribal 19 governments, nongovernmental organizations, and 20 individuals) in, environmental conflict resolution pro-

21 ceedings involving Federal agencies.".
